"ELECTRICAL SAFETY ON THE JOB" CALENDAR CONTEST

Welcome to our annual "Electrical Safety on the Job" calendar contest for the children, grandchildren, nieces and nephews of our employees, held to **bring safety home**. Please note that this year there is **one** new rule. We look forward to even more participation this year, and another fantastic calendar for 2011!

The rules for the annual contest are as follows:

1. Entry is open to MEC Industrial employees' children, grandchildren, nieces and nephews between the ages of 5 and 12. There are four age categories, and three winners will be selected from each age category:
 - Ages 5-6
 - Ages 7-8
 - Ages 9-10
 - Ages 11-12
2. The drawing must relate to the theme "Electrical Safety on the Job" and should illustrate an example of safety at work. As you know, the description of the workplace is wide-ranging – it can be an office, a hospital, a water treatment plant, a power plant, on the road, a construction site, etc. *Encourage your children to be creative.*
3. The finished poster should be no larger than 11" x 14". Designs should be submitted on quality poster illustration board or heavy paper. Crayons or colored pencils only should be used.
4. Only one entry per child is allowed. Parents/sponsors are limited to verbal assistance only. All drawings must be an individual effort and be free-hand originals. No traced pictures, please.
5. Each poster must be returned with the completed **Entry Form**, and should include the contestant's name, age, address, telephone number, e-mail address (if available), and sponsoring MEC Industrial employee's name clearly printed.

Note - All entries will automatically be forwarded for entry into the Kiewit Safe Contest, so make sure the entry form is legible and complete.

8. All entries must be postmarked by **June 4, 2010**. All entries become the property of MEC once submitted; however, we will return all entries to the entrants. Send entries to:

9. Criteria for judging – creativity, and how well the poster expresses the contest theme "Electrical Safety on the Job".
10. Winning entries will be announced in June 2010 at the Canobie Lake Outing. We will choose three winners from each of the four age groups to be part of our 2011 Safety Calendar, and we will select one of the winning posters to be on our Safety Banner for the 2011 District Meeting.
11. **Prizes** will include a \$1,000 savings bond for the poster chosen for the banner; \$100 savings bond for the 12 posters chosen for the calendar. All participants will receive a \$25 gift certificate to Toys-R-Us.
